

League 101 for 2024

Adult 40 & Over Format

- All State and Sectional Championships will be played as 1 singles and 3 doubles, no change for this year
- If advancing to a National Adult 40 & Over Championship, teams will play 1 singles and 4 doubles in 2024.
- This requires that ALL teams registering in TennisLink MUST have a minimum of **9** players registered in case they are to advance to the National Championships.

Mixed Doubles League

- Southern Section and therefore all states under the Southern Section have adopted straight levels for the 2024 league season as follows:
 - 18 & Over: 2.5, 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, 10.0
 - 40 & Over: 2.5*, 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5
 - 55 & Over: 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5
 - 65 & Over: 3.0, 3.5, 4.0
- This applies to all Local Leagues and State Championships.
- If a team advances to the National Championships, they will be playing against teams of other sections playing the “Combined” levels; 6.0, 7.0, 8.0, 9.0, and 10.0.
- Regulations require that players on Mixed Doubles teams now abide by the same rules as straight level Adult League teams.
 - Players can play up .5 level, for example a 3.0 player can play on a 3.5 team, however, a 3.0 player cannot play on a 4.0 team.
- Mixed Doubles ratings will only count toward an NTRP rating IF you do NOT participate in any Adult League, 18 & Over, 40 & Over, 55 & Over, 65 & Over. You would earn a Mixed Exclusive rating.

Leagues that do NOT count toward your NTRP Rating are:

- Combo Doubles
- Singles
- Adult 70 & Over
- Adult 75 & Over

Leagues that DO count toward your NTRP Rating are:

- Adult 18, 40, 55 & Over – Spring Season
- Adult 65 & Over
- **Tri-Level – New starting in 2024**
