

League 101 for 2025

New in South Carolina

- USTA SC Leagues will follow a statewide calendar
- State only teams will follow the new singleton regulation
- Updated Local League at State levels
- Full Team Default regulation written to be easier to understand. Teams with a full team default are not eligible to advance beyond the local season
- Match Scores must be submitted by the USTA SC end of league deadline (found on the USTA SC calendar)

Mixed Doubles League

Southern and South Carolina will continue to play straight level for Mixed League

- New for 2025
 - Self-rated and appealed players will earn strikes during the Mixed season
 - Players that earn 3 strikes during the season will be promoted or DQ'd to a higher level. The process is the same as during the advancing Adult season (Spring in SC).

- Not new, but re-stating
 - Mixed Doubles ratings will only count toward an NTRP rating IF you do NOT participate in any Adult League, 18 & Over, 40 & Over, 55 & Over, 65 & Over. You would earn a Mixed Exclusive rating.

Leagues that do NOT count toward your NTRP Rating are:

- Combo Doubles
- Singles
- Adult 70 & Over
- Adult 75 & Over

Leagues that DO count toward your NTRP Rating are:

- Adult 18, 40, 55 & Over – Spring Season
- Adult 65 & Over
- Tri-Level
